

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ANNALS OF WYOMING: THE WYOMING HISTORY JOURNAL 5/2020

Thank you for your interest in submitting originally researched and previously unpublished articles to *Annals of Wyoming*, the quarterly scholarly journal published by the Wyoming State Historical Society. The journal celebrates the people and places that have shaped the Wyoming experience, and is only available to members of the Society. We believe to study the past is to understand the present and prepare for our future. *Annals of Wyoming* is published in partnership with the Wyoming Department of State Parks & Cultural Resources, and the American Heritage Center/University of Wyoming. These guidelines are helpful tips before you call, send or e-mail about submitting manuscripts and photos for consideration. Following these guidelines increases our ability to respond to your submissions in a timely manner.

Manuscripts:

The editor welcomes manuscripts and photographs on every aspect of the history of Wyoming and the West. Appropriate for submission are unpublished, research-based articles that provide new information, or that offer new interpretations of historical events. There is no compensation for manuscripts published in *Annals of Wyoming*.

1. All manuscripts should be double-spaced in 12-point font with endnotes. Complete manuscripts (text and end notes combined) should total no more than 10,000-13,000 words. Regarding style refer to the *Chicago Manual of Style*, sixteenth edition, and to recent back issues of *Annals of Wyoming*. Submitted illustrations should be sent separately, with captions and source, as jpegs. Authors are responsible for securing permissions for illustrations.
2. Please do not send unsolicited articles by email or mail without consulting with us first. We cannot acknowledge or return unsolicited manuscripts. Queries should be made directly to the editor at carl.hallberg@wyo.gov.
